BAIL ORDER

1. The present bail application has been moved by the accused Lakhvir Singh through counsel for release him on bail in FIR No. 5 dated 8.01.2022 u/s 379/411 IPC. The applicant/accused has submitted that he has been falsely implicated in the present case. Nothing is to be recovered in the present case and he is not required by police for further investigation. He will not leave India without prior permission of the court. This application is the first regular bail application of the accused and no such application is pending or decided by any court of law.

2. In reply, the prosecution has submitted that stolen motor cycles have been recovered from the accused. Therefore, prima facie case has been made out against the accused under Section 379/411 IPC. Therefore, the application may be dismissed.

3. Heard. This application for regular bail has been moved by the accused Lakhvir Singh through counsel. A perusal of file reveals that the accused is alleged to have committed offences under Section 379,411,483 IPC. This court is of the view that the accused is no more required for custodial interrogation and no useful purpose is going to served by keeping the applicant/accused behind bars. Rather he will be a

burden upon the state exchequer. Moreover, the presentation of challan in the present case and conclusion of trial will take time. Offence under Section 483 IPC is bailable. Hence, the bail application stands allowed. Accused is directed to furnish bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety in the like amount. Papers be attached with the main file.
