O R D E R

1. This application for regular bail has been filed by

applicant/accused, Simranjeet Singh @ Sunny @ Jujhar Singh son of Jagdish Singh, in case FIR No.22 dated 10.02.2012 for offences under sections 307/326/324/34 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sultanwind, Amritsar.

2. On notice, Public Prosecutor opposed the bail application.

3. I have heard counsel for the applicant/accused and the Public Prosecutor for the State and have gone through the record.

4. As per allegations appearing on the record, on 07.02.2012 complainant Balbir Singh alias Beera son of Jaswant Singh and his wife Dimple were going to Chakki Wali Gali, Kot Mit Singh for taking medicine. At about 8.30 p.m. when they were 10/15 steps short of Tarn Taran Road, from other side a black colour motor cycle Pulsar being driven by a young man with hair cut was coming. Jujhar Singh son of Gursharanbir Singh and Bikramjit Singh alias Tikka son of Kulwant Singh were sitting on the pillion of the motorcycle. The motor cycle was stopped ahead of him. Both the pillion riders were armed with datars. Jujhar Singh after alighting from the motor cycle immediately raised a lalkara that earlier Beera had saved himself and he should not go scot free and be killed. Thereupon, Bikramjit Singh alias Tikka gave blow with datar at him, hitting on left side of his forehead. Then Jujhar Singh gave three

blows of datar, hitting him on the left leg and near the knee. Then, unknown young man took out a datar from motor cycle and gave blow at him, hitting on the right side of his head. Then, Bikramjit Singh alias Tikka gave second blow with his datar, hitting on his left arm. Then, Jujhar Singh gave two blows with his datar, hitting on the back of his head. He and his wife raised alarm of MAR DITTA MAR DITTA. Seeing the gathering of people, all the assailants fled away with their respective weapons on the motor cycle.

5. During investigation, name of the applicant was culled out to be the person riding the motorcycle and who gave datar blows on the head of complainant Balbir Singh. Non-applicants Bikramjit Singh and Jujhar Singh were arrested but present applicant could not be arrested and was declared a proclaimed offender vide order dated 30.10.2013. Trial against non-applicants Bikramjit Singh and Jujhar Singh was conducted and they have already been convicted and sentenced by my learned predecessor vide judgment dated 24.12.2015. Now, the applicant has been arrested in this case on 03.05.2019 after obtaining his production warrants.

6. Serious allegations are there against the applicant. Specific injury with datar is attributed to him on the head i.e. vital part of body of complainant Balbir Singh. He remained absconded for a period of more

than 5½ years. The applicant is also involved in other criminal cases including one murder case. So, there is every likelihood of applicant again absconding from the court proceedings, if released on bail. Thus, finding no merit in the present bail application, the same stands dismissed. File be consigned to record room.
