ORDER

Present bail application is filed by the above mentioned
accused-applicants under Section 482 of BNSS.

2. Notice of the bail application was given to the State. No reply
was filed by the State.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the accused/applicants and
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State assisted by learned

counsel for the complainant and have gone through the record with their able assistance.

4. Learned counsel for the accused/applicants has argued that the accused-applicants are innocent. No offence under Section 333 BNS was ever committed but is added just to make the case non bailable. Only simple injuries are inflicted to the complainant, as per MLRs. Accused-applicants are ready to join the investigation. Therefore, in the event of their arrest, they be released on bail.

5. On the other hand, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State assisted by learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the application and argued that the occurrence took place on 04.09.2025 at 09:00 p.m. inside the house of the complainant Balwinder Singh. Baldev Singh and others trespassed into the house of complainant at night. They were armed with deadly weapons. They started destroying the articles in the house. When they were asked to stop, Mithu son of Baldev Singh gave blow of '*dattar*' (machete) on the right arm of Balwinder Singh. Baldev Singh gave blow of hatchet on his back. Balkar Singh @ Nigro damaged the AC with bat, Gopi son of Kanail Singh damaged the water bank with the sword. When Gurpreet Kaur came at the spot, whose house was also damaged. Jugraj Singh gave blow of '*dattar*' (machete) on Raj Kaur wife of Balwant Singh. Arshdeep Singh @ Akki son of Baldev Singh also caused injuries to Pooja. Thus, accused-applicants are not entitled to bail.

6. After hearing rival contentions, I have perused the file. MLRs are also perused. In the MLR of Jugraj Singh, two lacerated wounds, blunt

and simple in nature are reported, in the MLR of Pooja, only complain of pain is reported without any physical injury, in the MLR of Balwinder Singh, one injury of complain is pain is reported, in the MLR of Arshdeep Singh, one lacerated wound, simple in nature is reported. Injuries are simple in nature. Custodial investigation is not required, in such a case. Therefore, the present application is allowed. Accused-applicants shall join the investigation within 10 days and in the event of their arrest, Investigating Officer is directed to release them on bail, upon furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer. This order is subject to conditions under Section 482(2) of the BNSS, 2023. The accused/applicants shall co-operate with the investigation and shall not directly or indirectly influence any witness or tamper with the evidence.

7. The present bail application be consigned to the Judicial Record Room, Kapurthala.
