Accused on bail with Sh. Neeraj Bhardwaj, Advocate, Ld. LAC from DLSA West, THC, Delhi.

Ms Simran Kaur, the wife of injured Sh. Harvinder Singh has appeared. She submits that due to the injury caused on head to Sh. Harvinder Singh in this offence, Sh. Harvinder Singh is in such a position that he is unable to testify and that he is not even in a position to recognize his family members.

IO SI Naseeb Singh has drawn my attention to the observation dated 13.2.2021 of Dr. Sweta Singhla, who has mentioned that due to post traumatic stress disorder, patient was not in a condition to give statement. It is submitted that the condition of the witness has not improved.

Ms Simran Kaur submits that the victim should be compensated from Victim Compensation Scheme. She submits that he will move application to that effect.

In view of this disability, Ld. Additional Public Prosecution submits that he does not want to examine Sh. Harvinder Singh as a witness. It is submitted that due to aforesaid reason Sh. Harvinder Singh was not cited as a prosecution witness.

IO SI Naseeb Singh submits that further investigation is being conducted by the police for which blood sample of Sh. Harvinder Singh is required. However, the family members of Sh. Harvinder Singh are not permitting for taking of blood sample of Sh. Harvinder Singh. Ms Simran Kaur submits that she will cooperate with the police in taking blood sample of Sh. Harvinder Singh.

It is submitted by IO SI Naseeb Singh that supplementary charge sheet would be filed after completion of investigation. Accordingly, the case is adjourned for filing of supplementary charge sheet.
