One bail application of accused is pending. Reply has been filed.

Arguments are heard.

Ld. Addl. PP has strongly opposed the bail application submitting that it is the third time that the accused had absented and therefore, no leniency should be shown to the accused this time. On the other hand, Id. LAC for accused submits that accused undertakes that he would be careful in appearing in the Court on each and every date in future.

I have considered rival submissions. I am of the opinion that he has been frequently absenting on various important dates. Therefore, now, no leniency can be shown to him. Accordingly, I dismiss his bail application. However, this Court would try to expedite his case.

As per report on the summons of Dr. Akshay Narayan, he has left the hospital and has gone to Kerala. Hence, issue summons to MS, GGS Hospital to depute some other Doctor conversant with the handwriting of Dr. Akshay Narayan to testify in the Court on his behalf. Also, issue fresh summons to Dr. Punit Atri at his residential address in terms of previous order.
