2. Following issues arise for adjudication:

1. Whether late Suparna Rajguru left behind a will dated 10.12.2020 in sound disposing mind? OPP
2. Whether the petitioner is entitled to grant of LOA in respect of the estate of late Suparna Rajguru in terms of the above said Will? OPP
3. Whether the petition is liable to be dismissed since the Will propounded by the petitioner is a forged document? OPR2
4. Relief

No other issue arises or is pressed for. List of witnesses be filed within 15 days from today.

Ld. Counsel for respondent no. 2 submits that an application under section 151 CPC seeking expert examination of Will propounded by the petitioner is pending consideration.
