The matter was listed today for arguments on the pending application moved on behalf of resp. no.2 seeking examination of the signatures purported testatrix on the Will set up by the petitioner from forensic lab or from a handwriting expert. After the last date of hearing, an application was moved by the petitioner also seeking examination of the signatures of the purported testatrix of the Will set up by him, through a handwriting expert Mr. Kamal Kant Khandelwal.

After hearing arguments on both the applications, the Court is of the understanding that in effect, both the petitioner and also resp. no.2 want the document to be examined in respect of the signatures of the purported testatrix. I see no impediment in allowing both the applications. The matter is adjourned to 06.06.2023 to enable the petitioner to get document/s containing admitted signatures of the purported testatrix.

On 06.06.23, ld. Counsel for resp. no.2 shall furnish details of the expert from whom he wishes to examine the Will. If available on the next date, respective experts will be permitted to take photographs of the Will for expert examination in the presence of the parties/ld. Counsel.
