Accused was taken on 01 day PC and then he was brought at the PS. Accused has taken us at the house of his co-accused Kalu and we also searched for another accused Madan but they could not be traced. Accused had also taken us at his residence but nothing was recovered from there. I identify accused Sunny, present before the Court. (correctly identified).

I alongwith IO left the PS at about 11:00-11:30 for coming to Tis Hazari Courts. I do not remember if IO made any departure entry at the PS. We reached Tis Hazari Court within

01-1 ½ hours. I do not remember the name of Ld. Magistrate and the Court no., where the accused surrendered himself. I do not remember if IO had obtained signature of any court staff including the Naib court on the documents, prepared by the IO, on which I had signed as a witness. I do not remember if IO gave information to any of the relative of accused regarding his arrest.

I do not know if IO made any arrival entry at the PS. I do not remember the time when we visited the residence of accused Kalu. It is correct that other houses were situated, near the house of accused Kalu. IO called the neighbour but no notice was given to any of them to join the investigation. It is wrong to suggest that I did not join the investigation of the present case at any point of time or that IO had taken my signature on the documents at the PS. It is wrong to suggest that accused Sunny has been falsely implicated at the instance of complainant.

On that day, at about 01:00-02:00 PM, one Honda Civic car bearing last four digit as 8500, passed from that spot in a very high speed and in a rash manner. I noticed that the driver of the Honda Civic struck against one motorcycle and the police official, who was sitting on the motorcycle was fallen on the road. That police official sat on my motorcycle as a pillion rider and asked me to chase that Honda Civic car. Some public person got stopped the driver of that Honda Civic car and the person who was driving the Honda Civic car was apprehended and produced before the police officer, who was sitting as a pillion rider on my motorcycle, by the public person. On interrogation,, the name of the driver of the Honda Civic Car was revealed as Lawrance and from his possession some brown colour substance in a packet was recovered. I alongwith police officer had taken Lawrance to PS Mohan Garden and later on that person was taken to PS

On 26.08.2021, I was posted at PS Vasant Kunj, South. On that day, I alongwith HC Pradeep went to Bihar to apprehend proclaimed offender namely Anil Kumar Ray, s/o Ramashish, r/o VPO Rampur, PS Garkha, District Saran, Bihar.

On 28.08.2021, we made our arrival entry vide DD No. 833 at PS Garkha. One police official SI Vimlesh Kumar Singh of PS Garkha joined us and we went at Jagdamba Book Depo, Garkha as we had received the secret information that accused Anil Kumar Ray is present there and he can be arrested if a raid is conducted. Two persons were standing near Jagdamba Book Depo. I inquired from both those persons and there names were revealed as Lal kumar Mohan and Anil Kumar Ray. I checked the ID of Anil Kumar Ray and then he was arrested by me. I informed him that he was proclaimed offender in the present case. I prepared arrest memo and personal search memo, now **Ex.PW4/A and Ex.PW4/B** bearing my signature at point A. After the arrest of the accused, accused was produced before the SHO of PS Garkha. I also made DD No. 839 dt. 28.08.2021 at PS

contd...

Garkha, Bihar regarding transit remand of the accused which is now **Ex.PW4/C**. Later on I produced the accused before the concerned Chhapra Court and the transit remand of 48 hours was given to produce the accused at Delhi.

On 30.08.2021, we alongwith accused reached at Delhi. I made arrival entry at PS Vasant Kunj vide DD No. 13-,which is now **Ex.PW4/D**. Before this, I got accused medically examined at Safdarjung Delhi. I also got accused medically examined at Swasthya Kendra Garkha, Bihar on 28.08.2021. Accused was produced before the concerned court on 30.08.2021.

I have seen the GD No. 7-A dt. 26.08.2021 regarding our departure from Delhi, which is now **Ex.PW4/E** and the arrival entry at PS Garkha is now **Ex.PW4/F**. I identify accused Anil Ray, present before the Court. (correctly identified).

XXXX by Sh. Ashok Kumar Mishra, Ld. Counsel for the accused.

Permission from the senior officer was obtained for going outstation. I am not aware if IO had placed on record such permission. The arrival/departure entry was made at PS Basant Kunj South on computer. The present case pertains to PS Nangloi. Record is maintained at each PS about all the proclaimed offenders. I have not brought such record. It is wrong to suggest that no such record is maintained or that due to this reason, I have not brought such record. After taking permission from the senior official, we went to Bihar by private car. I have not mentioned the registration no. of the private car in the

contd...

departure entry. It is wrong to suggest that we did not go to Bihar by private car or that due to this reason, the registration no is not mentioned in the departure entry. It is wrong to suggest that I have taken the private car without obtaining any authority from the senior officer. I do not know if any conveyance charge were taken from the department for travelling in a private car from Delhi to Bihar. It is wrong to suggest that we did not make any arrival/departure entry at the local PS or that the same were later on manipulated in the present case. It is wrong to suggest that HC Pradeep was already known to accused or that he has been falsely arrested in the present case to earn reward and appreciaion letter from the department. HC Pradeep and myself never worked at PS Nangloi. It is wrong to suggest that accused was not arrested from the place and in the manner as deposed by me. It is wrong to suggest that all the documents are ante-dated and ante-time and are manipulated documents. It is wrong to suggest that I am deposing falsely.

I do not remember the date, month and the year but it was before 17-18 years, at about 10:00-10:30 PM,, near Rajdhani Park, someone caused injuries at my back with blade and I became unconscious and later on I regained my consciousness in a hospital. I do not know who caused injuries on my person. I could not see those persons as they caused injuries from my back. I have nothing more to day.

At this stage, Ld. Addl PP seeks permission to cross examine the witness as he is resiling from his previous statement u/s 161 of Cr.P.C.

Heard. Allowed.

XXXXXX by Sh. Subhash Chauhan, Ld. Addl. PP for the State.

Police did not meet me and did not record my statement in the present case. It is wrong to suggest that police inquired from me and recorded my statement.

I did not state in my statement that on 24.08.2006 I received a call from my friend Pappu Mishra, who informed me that some altercation had taken place between him and thekedar namely Tribhuvan and Om Prakash Shashri or that at 09:40 PM, I reached Rajdhani Park Bus stand, where I saw Tribhuwan and

contd...

Om Prakash alongwith two other boys or that Tribhuwan pointed towards us and stated, ‘ *yahi wo ladka hai jo dada banta hai*’ or that Om Prakash Shashtri uttered the words to Pappu Mishra to the effect, ‘ *tera jyada garam khoon hai*’ or that Om Prakash Shashti and other boys caught hold of pappu or that Tribhuwan inflicted injury on the person of Pappu Mishra with a cutter blade. Confronted with statement now PW5/MarkA, where it is so recorded.

I also did not state in my statement that Om Prakash and other caught hold of me or that they exhorted to kill me or that Tribhuwan caused injuries on my leg, back and other part of the body with the blade or that we both fallen on the ground, smeared with blood or that all the accused persons ran away from there. Confronted with statement PW5/MarkA, where it is so recorded.

I do not know the accused present before the Court, I have never seen him. He never inflicted any injury on my person. It is wrong to suggest that today I am not deposing the true facts to the effect that on 24.08.2006 accused Om Prakash Shashtri, Tribhuwan and the accused present before the court today, in furtherance of common intention, inflicted injury on my person and on the person of Pappu Mishra. It is wrong to suggest that I am not identifying the accused, present before the Court deliberately. It is wrong to suggest that I have compromised the matter with the accused or that I want to save the accused from

contd...

legal punishment.

I can identify the case property, if shown to me.

At this stage, MHC(M) produced the destruction certificate of the case property of the present case, as per entry serial no. 21. The destruction certificate is now taken on record and same is now **Ex.PW7/PX1**.

At this stage, MHC(M) produced 38 cloth sealed parcels and all these parcels are duly sealed with the seal of A Star II CRIME and with the seal of SS and all the 38 cloth parcels bears the particulars of the present case, signature of HC Narender and HC Mintu Yadav besides the signature of SI Dinesh Kumar and SHO. (on some of the pullandas, the complete legible seal of A STAR II CRIME is not there).

I have seen the aforesaid 38 cloth seal parcels. These are the same cloth parcels, in which the samples were drawn. There were total 76 samples. The case property is collectively Ex.PW7/PY1 to Ex.PW7/PY38.

MHC(M) also produced two original notices us/ 50 of NDPS Act, addressed to accused Chandan Shah and Krishan Deo

Ray. Both the notices are now taken on record. I have seen both the notices. These are the same notices which were served upon the accused persons. The notices are now **Ex.PW7/PY39** and **Ex.PW7/PY40**.

It was already Dark when I reached at the spot and it was already sunset. I was present at the spot for about 05-05:30 hours. The total raiding team members who had gone to the spot, remained present at the spot throughout a period of 05-05:30 hours. ACP came at the spot after about 02 hours from the time of our reaching there. I have no knowledge as to how and on whose instruction, ACP came at the spot. Vol. IO can tell so. ACP remained present at the spot for about 3.5 hours. No Ld. Magistrate was called at the spot in the present case. This is my 3-4 case under NDPS Act in which I have participated in the raid. One of my earlier, where I had participated was on Heroin and the other case was of Smack. I was aware of various substances covered under NDPS Act as we were given training during our service period. I had seen Ganja prior to the present case as I had participated in two other earlier cases which were other than those 3-4 cases, which I had mentioned earlier. Vol. In those cases, I was not cited as a witness. It is wrong to suggest that I am deposing falsely or that I had never participated in any case booked under NDPS Act.
