Criminal Bail Appln.No.598/2026**Satish Gorakh Ghadge & Ors.
Vs.
State of Maharashtra****ORDER BELOW EXH.1**

01] This is an application filed for anticipatory bail as per section 482 of the B.N.S.S., in connection with Crime No.211/2026 registered by Beed Rural Police Station, Dist. Beed for the offences punishable under section 118(1), 115(2), 352, 351(2), 191(2), 193(3) read with Section 190 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

02] Prosecution's case in brief, is as under ;

Informant – Rameshwar Bhimrao Ghadge lodged F.I.R. on 15.06.2026 alleging that, on the said day at about 07.00 a.m. while he was going to Beed from Aher Wadgaon the applicant and co-accused obstructed his motorcycle. Accused raised quarrel on the cause of cutting branches of Indian Berry by informant's brother Dnyaneshwar. Though, the informant told them that, Dnyaneshwar had taken permission from Pravin Ghadge. Accused Gorakh Ghadge threw axe towards informant which hit him above his right eye brow. Harishchandra threw stone which hit on the left side of his head above ear. Accused Pravin, Ananta and Satish i.e. applicants assaulted him with kicks and fist blows, abused and threatened to kill him. Hence, the F.I.R.

03] Applicants have claimed bail on the grounds that, they are innocent and have not committed any crime as alleged. There is no recovery alleged to be effected from them. Applicant No.2 was not present at the spot at the relevant time. He is preparing for police recruitment. Applicant No.1 is suffering from brain disease and require regular medical treatment. The applicants have no criminal antecedents. Applicants are resident of the given addresses. They are ready to co-operate in investigation and abide by the conditions that may be imposed. On these grounds, they have prayed to grant anticipatory bail.

04] Prosecution has resisted the application by filing say at Exh.13. It is the say of the prosecution that there is strong prima facie case made out against the applicants. There is active participation of the applicants in commission of crime. The investigation is in progress and custody of the present applicants is necessary for further investigation of crime. If the applicants will be released on bail, then it is likely that, they will pressurize the prosecution witnesses, interfere in the investigation and tamper the prosecution's evidence. On these grounds, prosecution has prayed to reject the bail application.

05] Heard advocate for the applicants/accused and learned A.P.P. for the State. They argued as per application and say as referred above. To avoid repetition, I find it would be just and proper not to reproduce the arguments of both the sides.

06] Considering the rival submissions of both sides, I find that, the allegations made against the applicants are that they assaulted the informant with fist blows and kicks. There is no recovery alleged to be effected from them. The Medico-Legal Certificate of the injured is not produced on record. Applicants No.2 and 3 are young boys aged 20 and 17 years respectively. In such situation, I find that, applicants are entitled to get anticipatory bail and pass following order.

ORDER

01. Application is allowed.
02. In the event of arrest of Applicants/accused No. 1) **Satish Gorakh Ghadge, 2) Pravin Harishchandra Ghadge** in Crime No.211/2026 registered by Beed Rural Police Station, Dist. Beed for the offences punishable under section 118(1), 115(2), 352, 351(2), 191(2), 193(3) read with Section 190 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, be released on executing P. R. Bond of Rs. 50,000/- (Rs. Fifty Thousand only) and one surety of like amount, on the following terms and conditions.
03. In the event of arrest **Applicant/JCL No.3) Ananta Harishchandra Ghadge under guardian of mother Urmila w/o. Harishchandra Ghadge** in Crime No.211/2026 registered by Beed Rural Police Station, Dist. Beed for the offences punishable under section 118(1), 115(2), 352, 351(2), 191(2), 193(3) read with Section 190 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 be released on executing P. R. Bond of Rs. 50,000/- (Rs. Fifty thousand only) and

one surety of like amount of his guardian, on the following terms and conditions.

- (b) Applicants shall not indulge in any offence.
- (c) Applicants shall not directly or indirectly contact and pressurize the informant and prosecution witnesses and tamper the prosecution evidence.
- (d) Applicants shall not leave the jurisdiction of the Court without prior permission of the concerned Court till further order.
- (e) Violation of any of the conditions imposed shall amount to cancellation of bail forthwith.

04. Inform to concerned police station accordingly.
