Accused with Ld. LAC.

AR the complainant submits that the matter has been compromised amicably between the parties and he does not wish to proceed with the matter against the accused and complainant has received the amount of Rs.10,000/- only (which is cheque in question in the present case) and he has also stated that the complainant company does not have any other cheque belonging to the accused in its possession. He requests that the present complaint be disposed of as compounded. Let his statement to this effect be recorded.

Separate statement is recorded.

In view of the statement of AR for the complainant, the matter is disposed of as compromised. Accused is acquitted. Surety, if any, is discharged and surety bond, if any, stands cancelled. Documents, if any be returned after due verification.
