Deposition of witness No. **PW-16** for the prosecution recorded on oath or solemn affirmation under provision of OATHS ACT, 1969 (Act, 44 of 1969) on this **19th Day of May, 2025** in the English language interpreted by me.

Name –**Sri Sibbu Ranjan Datta**, S/O- Lt. Bimal Chandra Datta, Age of 74 year Residence of –Currently I am residing at Sabroom, Ananda Para, PS-Sabroom, District - South Tripura, Occupation –Retired Person, Hindu, Literate.

Examination-in-chief:-

I am the complainant of this instant case. On 28.05.2024 I filed this case against FEDCO. On 23.05.2024 at about 10.30 PM near Sabroom Sub-Divisional hospital my son got electrocuted by electric wire on the public Road and fallen in the drain. Some local people found him and informed the matter to Sabroom PS, Fire Service and brought him to Sabroom Sub-Divisional Hospital. Upon information given by Dipak Das I went to Sabroom Sub-Divisional Hospital and found my son's dead body. Thereafter, Post-Mortem conducted and hospital authority handed over the dead body to my son-in-law. Next day police came my to house but no action taken by the authority. For that reason on 28.05.2024 I came to Sabroom Court and advocate clerk Shyamal Gosh prepared written ejahar as per my version. I

filed that ejahar on the same day in the Sabroom PS. My son died because of negligent act committed by FEDCO Sabroom, Branch who without proper check given the electric connection. This is the written complaint and there is my signature on it. Upon identification the signature has been marked as **Exbt. P-10.**

Cross- Examination:-

1. In my written ejahar I did not mention any name of the accused persons.
2. At this juncture Ld. Defence counsel draws attention towards his 161 Cr.P.C., recorded statement, where it is not mentioned that “Upon information given by Dipak Das I went to Sabroom Sub-Divisional Hospital and found my son’s dead body”. Upon asking witness stated he told that to IO. This portion subjected verification by the IO.
3. On that alleged date of incident it was raining.
4. It is not a fact that due to heavy rainfall and thunderstorm that accident occurred.
5. It is not a fact that my entire examination-in-chief is false.
