Accused Sri Ratul Bordoloi has been produced from judicial custody through video conferencing. He is represented by learned Asst LADC. Accused made no complain on any other aspect.

Today the case is also fixed for necessary order on petition no.2187/26. Heard learned Asst. PP as well as learned Asst. LADC representing the accused.

Copy is already furnished to the accused.

There are sufficient incriminating materials on record to proceed 447/294/352/353 of IPC against the accused person. Accordingly particulars of the offences are read over and explained to the accused persons.

Perused the case record along with the petition no.2187/26 filed by the accused wherein he intends to plead guilty in this case for the alleged offence.

Heard learned Asst. LADC as well as learned Asst. PP.

The plea of the accused appears to be voluntarily and the same is accepted.

The plea of guilt of the accused is recorded in separate sheet(s) through video conferencing and his signatures are taken by the messenger at District Jail, North Lakhimpur and after taking his signatures, the same is kept tagged with the case record.

Accordingly, the accused **Sri Ratul Bordoloi** is convicted for the offence(s) punishable u/s **447/294/352/353** of IPC on his plea of guilt.

The offender prayed for leniency stating that he had already undergone 29 days at the initial stage of the proceeding and during the trial of this case.

I have heard both sides.

Also considered the provisions of the Probation of Offenders Act, 1958.

Here in this case, considering the nature of the alleged offence(s), his detention period as UTP and also taking note of the fact that no previous conviction has been proved or alleged against him, I am of the view that it is a fit case to provide some benefit under the said Act to the offender.

Accordingly, in exercise of power u/s 4 of the Probation of Offender's Act, 1958; the convict Sri Ratul Bordoloi is not sentenced to any punishment at once, but he shall pay fine amount of **Rs. 100/-** (rupees one hundred) against conviction under section **447** of IPC; fine amount of **Rs. 100/-** (rupees one hundred) is imposed upon him against conviction under section **294** of IPC; fine amount of **Rs. 100/-** (rupees one hundred) is imposed upon him against conviction under section **352** of IPC and fine amount of **Rs. 200/-** (rupees two hundred) is imposed upon him against conviction under section **353** of IPC, totaling to **Rs. 500/-** (rupees five hundred). I/D to **07** (seven) days of simple imprisonment for each default, to be served consecutively.

Inform all concerned accordingly.

Copy of the order be furnished.

The instant case is disposed of accordingly.
