It is stated by Id. Counsel for the petitioner that petitioner as well as her husband are residents of Canada.

Four banks have been made respondents in this matter and they are not required to contest the present petition and also none of them is a necessary party. Therefore, I order that they be deleted from the array of parties.

Perusal of the record reveals that some inadequate details have been provided in the petition about the assets of deceased, lockers which he maintained in different banks. Issue notice to the concerned Bank Managers to furnish the locker No., Bank account No., if any, maintained by the deceased with them on filing PF/RC. Petitioner is directed to file amended memo of parties on or before the next date of hearing.

Put up the case on 22.11.2019 for further proceedings.
