Statement of HC Baljinder Singh, No.847/Khanna, posted at P.S. Doraha, District Ludhiana has been recorded that accused Narinder Chopra has joined the investigation on 29.07.2026. He is not required for further investigation at this stage.

2. Order dated 20.07.2026 granting bail to Narinder Chopra is made absolute and in the event of his arrest, applicant/accused shall be released on anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of arresting officer on complying with the conditions prescribed under Section 482(2) BNSS, 2023 as under:-

- a) That the applicant/accused shall make himself available for investigation by the police officer as and when required.
- b) That applicant/accused directly or indirectly shall not make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or any police officer.
- c) That applicant/accused shall not leave the country without prior permission of the court.

3. Copy of the said order be sent to the concerned SHO of P.S. Doraha, District Ludhiana. File of present bail application be consigned to the record room.
