ORDER :

By way of this order, I shall dispose of the anticipatory bail
application of the petitioner, particulars of which are given above.

2. As per the case of the prosecution, there are the allegations against
the applicant-accused that he, along with co-accused, hatched a criminal

conspiracy with a view to cheat The Hisar Jind Co-operative Milk producers Union Ltd. Milk Plant, Jind by labeling the sticker of its name on the adulterated 'Ghee' and in pursuance of said criminal conspiracy, applicant-accused along with co-accused was also involved in preparing adulterated 'Ghee'.

3. Notice of the application was given to the State through Public Prosecutor. Reply to the application was filed wherein the contents of the FIR have been reiterated.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the accused-applicant and learned Public Prosecutor and have gone through the case file carefully.

5. Learned counsel for the accused-applicant has argued that the allegations levelled in the FIR are completely false, concocted and baseless. It has been further argued that he has nothing to do with the alleged offence(s). It has further been argued that nothing is to be recovered from the accused-applicant, so, custodial interrogation of the accused-applicant is not required. However, the accused-applicant is ready to join the investigation, as and when required by the police.

6. On the other hand, learned Public Prosecutor for the State assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, has opposed the bail application by arguing that there are serious allegations against the accused-applicant, hence, he is not entitled for anticipatory bail.

7. As per the case of the prosecution, there are serious allegations against the accused with regard to commission of offences of cheating and

preparing the adulterated ghee in order to sell the same in the open market.

8. From the aforesaid allegations, it is crystal clear that applicant-accused, along with co-accused has committed serious offences of cheating and preparing adulterated ghee. As such, it is a case of preparing adulterated 'Ghee' for the purpose of sale in the open market. The sale of adulterated 'Ghee' in the open market shall be nothing but playing with the health of public at large. Now a days, such types of incidents of preparing adulterated food items are on rise. Since the safety and health of public at large is involved, therefore, person(s) involved in such activities need to be treated with hard hand in order to curb menace of preparing adulterated food items.

9. In these circumstances, this Court is of the opinion that custodial interrogation of the accused-applicant is necessary for unearthing the chain of sequence of events, which has led to the commission of offences. As such, the application for anticipatory bail filed by the accused-applicant stands dismissed. File be consigned to record room after due compliance.
