ORDER

1. This order of mine shall dispose of anticipatory bail application filed by the accused/applicant in the case mentioned above.
2. Notice of the bail application was issued to the state and Sh.Sahib Singh, learned APP appeared on behalf of the State. The concerned Ahlmad has reported that as per CIS system, this is the first anticipatory bail application of applicant/accused and no bail

application of the applicant/accused is pending or decided in the same FIR in the subordinate Court as well as High Court.

3. ASI Darshan Singh No.851/FZR P.S.Women Ferozepur has come present and suffered a statement that he identify the complainant present in the Court. There is likelihood of compromise between the parties.

4. Complainant Parvinder Kaur has also come present and suffered statement in the Court that she is complainant of the present case. She is ready to compromise the matter with the applicant/accused. She has no objection if the matter is sent to Mediation Center for effecting compromise between them and further, she has no objection if the applicant/accused is granted interim bail for appearing in the mediation center.

5. As far as the bail application of accused/applicant Palwinder Singh is concerned, admittedly, applicant/accused Palwinder Singh is husband of complainant. Since, the complainant is ready for compromise with applicant/accused as per the statement of complainant and further she has no objection if the applicant/accused is granted interim bail and further accused/applicant is ready to join the investigation, as such, the custodial interrogation of the

applicant/accused is not required. So this Court is of the considered opinion that an attempt should be made to enable the parties to amicably resolve the dispute between them.

6. Further keeping in view the law cited in 2014(3) RCR(Criminal) cited as **Arnesh Kumar Versus State of Bihar** and another, this Court is of considered opinion that the applicant/accused is directed to join the investigation within three days from today and in case of applicant doing so, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer. Applicant/accused and complainant are directed to appear before the Mediation Centre, Ferozepur on 13.10.2025.

7. Now to come up on 24.10.2025 for awaiting the report of the Mediation Centre, Ferozepur and the Investigating Officer/arresting officer.

8. Copy of this order be sent to Mediator-cum- Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Ferozepur immediately for necessary compliance.
