An application under order V rule 20 CPC has been filed on behalf of the plaintiff for service of defendant by way of substitute service through publication in Newspaper.

Ld counsel for the plaintiff submits that the given address of the defendant is the only last known address and no other address of defendant is available with the plaintiff.

In view of the abovesaid facts, since service of defendant through ordinary process is not possible, the application filed under order V rule 20 CPC stands **allowed**.

Defendant be served by way of publication in Newspaper "The Statesman". Publication charges be deposited directly with the News agency. Process be given dasti for the said purpose.

Ordinary summons be also issued on the given address of the defendant, where father of the defendant is residing, with direction to the process server to carry out the affixation of the summons and the plaint on the outer door of the house of the defendant, in case, father of the defendant refuses to receive the summons, as per Section 5 rule 17 CPC.

PF be filed for the said purpose within 05 days.
