**Arguments on the pending injunction
application of plaintiff heard today and record
perused.**

In the said application, plaintiff has made a
prayer to restrain the defendants from carrying out any
construction in the suit property and from creating any
third party interest in the suit property during the
pendency of the suit.

During the course of arguments, Ld.counsel for
defendants submitted that defendants will not raise
further construction in the suit property and as of
today, there exists a boundary wall in the suit property

without there being any roof and defendants will maintain the suit property in the same condition during the pendency of the present suit.

It is further submitted by Ld.counsel for defendants that defendants will not create any third party interest in the suit property during the pendency of this case.

Further, Ld.counsel for defendants has admitted that status of the construction in suit property as reflected in the photograph no.2 filed on record by plaintiff and defendants shall maintain the same, during the pendency of suit.

In the light of submission made by Ld.counsel for defendants, **the application filed is allowed and defendants are restrained from creating any third party interest in the suit property i.e. C-873 out of Khasra No. 40/13, admeasuring 25 sq.yards situated in the revenue estate of village Baprola abadi known as Dass Colony, New Delhi and shall not carry out any further construction in the suit**

property as shown in photograph no.2 filed on record by plaintiff and as admitted by ld.counsel for defendants during the course of arguments during the pendency of this case. The application stands disposed of.

Put up on 13.04.2020 for PE by way of affidavit with direction to ld.counsel for plaintiff to supply advance copy of the affidavit to the ld.counsel for defendants and payment of previous cost by defendant.
