By way of application u/s 151 CPC, exemption is sought from filing certified copies of certain documents. Allowed. Exemption granted.

In the present matter, DDA and MCD have been named as D-2 & D-3, respectively and notice u/s 80 CPC has not been served upon them. By way of application u/s 80 r/w Sec. 151 CPC, exemption from serving a notice upon them is sought contending that the relief claimed in the present suit and interim application is of urgent nature.

In view of above submissions, the application is being allowed. The plaintiff is exempted from serving the notice u/s 80 CPC. Accordingly, IA No. 01/2026 & 02/2026 are being disposed off.

Issue summons for settlement of issues and notice of interim application (IA No.03/2026) to defendants on filing of PF/ speed post/ Dasti, returnable for 12.08.2026.
