2) Whether the petitioner is entitled for issuance of letters of administration, on the basis of above said Will dated 06.08.2012? OPP.

3) Whether the will dated 06.08.2012 is a forged and fabricated document ? OPR-2

4) Relief

No other issue arises or is pressed for. List of witnesses be filed by petitioners as well as respondent no. 2 within 15 days from today.

Put up for petitioner's evidence on 20.07.2026 by way of affidavits. Advance copy of the affidavit of the witness to be examined on the next date be supplied to the opposite party atleast 10 days prior to the next date of hearing.
