Amardeep Singh alias Pannu Vs. State of Punjab

Record of the bail application not produced by the SHO/IO rather on the summons to produce record it is reported that the Investigating Officer ASI Narinder Mohan is on leave so, record cannot be produced. From the perusal of the case file, it transpires that the accused Amardeep Singh had surrendered in the Court on 26.06.2018 and since then he is in custody. From the perusal of the FIR placed on record, it transpires that the accused has been charge sheeted for the offence punishable under Section 379, 411 IPC and even on the summons dated 04.07.2018 it is reported that FIR no.138/2018 was registered for offence punishable under Section 379, 411 IPC. So, this Court is inclined dispose of the bail application even if, the record has not been produced in the Court.

Learned counsel for accused/applicant has submitted that accused/applicant is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case and has not committed any such offence and has falsely been

named by the police to save the real accused. It is further submitted that the accused/applicant wants to surrender himself today in the court in order to save himself from the illegal harassment at the hands of police. He further submitted that the accused/applicant undertake to abide by the terms and conditions to be imposed by this court if the accused/applicant be released on bail.

On notice being served learned APP for the state has opposed the bail application on the ground that the accused/applicant has been apprehended for commission of offence punishable under section 379/411 IPC and releasing the accused on bail, shall hamper the trial. As such, he prayed that the accused/applicant do not deserve the concession of bail.

I have considered the contradictory versions of contesting parties and have deliberated over the arguments advanced in the light of circumstances and submissions made.

Perusal of the case file reveals that accused/applicant has been arrested in the present case for commission of offence punishable under section 379/411 IPC. Conclusion of trial will take sufficient long time. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused/applicant behind the bars. Keeping in view the above discussion, accused/applicant Amardeep Singh alias Pannu is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of **Rs.50,000/- with one surety** in the like amount, failing which he be kept in custody.
