File is taken up today on the application (IA no. 1/2026) filed by the DH under Section 39 CPC for transfer of the decree of present execution.

Present: Sh. Keshav, Ld counsel for the DH.

Ld counsel for the DH submits that the decree of the present execution may be transferred to the court of Ld. Principal District & Sessions Judge, Rohini (North District), Delhi as property of the JD is situated there.

Heard. Case file perused.

The execution petition is fixed for 05.06.2026. Due to moving of present application, the case is taken up for hearing today and the date 05.06.2026 stands cancelled.

As per case file, JD as well as his property does not situate within the jurisdiction of this court. So, this court has no jurisdiction to execute the decree against the JD as well as his property, which is situated beyond the jurisdiction of this court.

Ld counsel for the DH has submitted that the factory of JD is situated at N-143, Ground Floor, Pkt-10, Sector-2, Bawana, Industrial Area and the decree of present execution may be sent to the court of Ld. Principal District & Sessions Judge, Rohini (North District), Delhi for execution, as per Section 39 of CPC.

Since the property of the JD is situated in Bawana within the local limit of the jurisdiction of Ld. Principal District & Sessions Judge, Rohini (North District), Delhi, the decree of present execution is transferred to the court of Ld. Principal District & Sessions Judge, Rohini (North District), Delhi for execution, as per Section 39 of CPC.

Transfer Certificate be issued accordingly.

Copy of this order alongwith transfer certificate, copy of decree and certificate of non-satisfaction of the decree be sent to Ld. Principal District & Sessions Judge, Rohini (North District), Delhi through speed post.

Application (IA no. 1/2026) stands disposed off accordingly.

Execution petition is also disposed off as decree of the present execution has been transferred for execution, as per Section 39 CPC.
