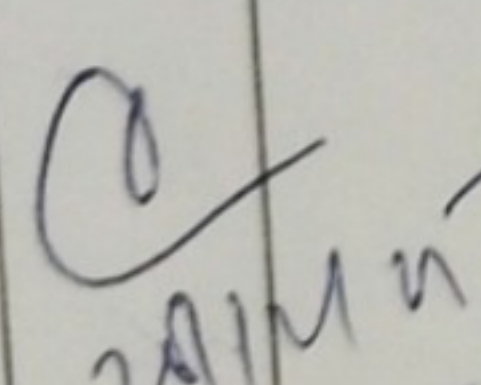

Seen the bail petition no: 2987 filed on behalf of the accused person namely, Shri Nurul Islam praying to allow him to go on bail. 5. The accused Shri Nurul Islam was arrested on 24/11/2025 in connection with Diphu P.S case no: 100/ 2025 under Section 21(a)/21(b)/27 of NDPS Act. 6. The prosecution has alleged that on the basis of a secret information on 24/11/2025, the accused Shri Nurul Islam was detained, and he was searched and upon searching him, suspected Heroin 1.23 Gms and 192 capsules of Symdex + weighing about 151 Grams was recovered from his possession; hence this case. 7. The prosecution has alleged that during the interrogation of the accused Shri Nurul Islam he had stated that he and accused Shri Amir	

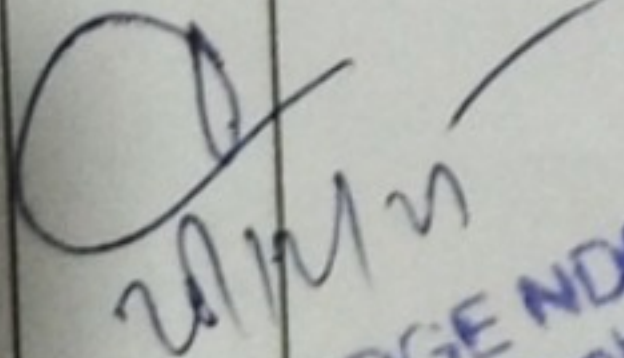

Continued 20/12/2025	Hussain used to consume drugs together sometimes and the drugs was brought by accused Shri Amir Hussain; as such the accused Shri Amir Hussain was arrested in this case. 8. The Ld. Counsel for the bail petitioner has submitted that accused Shri Nurul Islam may be released on bail as investigation has progressed considerably, and he is innocent and also because his wife is suffering from Brain Tumour and admitted to GMCH, Guwahati and there is no one to look after her or their minor children who is about 2 years of age. 9. The Ld. PP has submitted that there is sufficient material against the accused person; as such to reject the prayer for bail. 10. It would be pertinent to mention herein that no contraband was recovered from the physical possession of the accused, Shri Amir Hussain and he is already granted bail. 11. The perusal of case diary further reveals that the investigation
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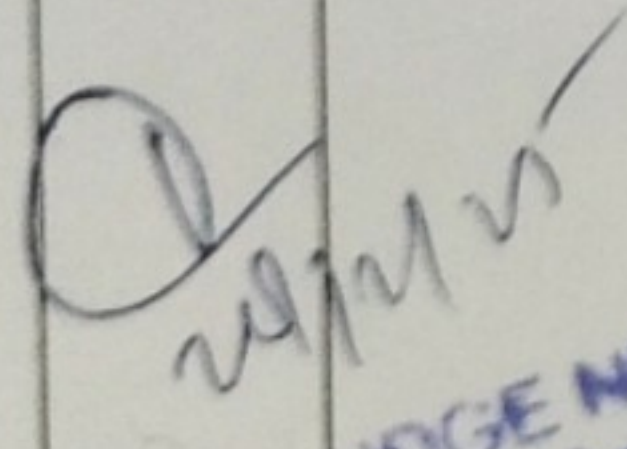

Continued 20/12/2025	has progressed considerably and since 28/11/2025 no investigation has taken place in this case. 12. It is further seen that the accused is a local person and there is less likelihood that he would abscond. 13. It is also seen that most of the material witnesses are police personnel and there is less likelihood of him influencing the witnesses. 14. In view of the above discussions, and considering the materials on record, and also considering the length of detention, I am of the considered opinion that the further custodial detention of the above-named accused would not be necessary for completion of the investigation; hence the prayer for bail is allowed. 15. The accused, Shri Nurul Islam is allowed to go on bail of Rs.50,000/- with one suitable surety of like amount and the accused is further directed to comply with the conditions laid under section 480(3) BNSS and directed that he shall not abscond; and not interfere with the
