

Criminal Appeal No. 06 / 2025

Subject: Combine Order below Applications Exh. 4 & 5 for Stay of execution and bail granted till appeal.

- 1) In this case, the appellant was convicted under **Section 325 and 114 of IPC** by the **Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sanand, Ahmedabad (Rural)** in **Criminal Case No. 3160/2021**.

The appellant was sentenced to **three years and six months of rigorous imprisonment** and directed to pay compensation of **Rs.10,000/-** each to witnesses. The appellant has filed the present appeal against this judgment. The primary contention of the appellant is that their arguments and evidence presented during the trial were not appropriately considered by the trial court, leading to their conviction. Therefore, the present appeal has been filed. The appellant has further argued that there is a strong possibility of success in this appeal. Considering this, the appellant has requested to be released on bail during the pendency of the appeal and to stay the execution of the sentence. The respondent was served with the notice.

- 2) I have considered the documents on hand and judgment passed by the trial court. Accordingly, I pass the following order:

:: O R D E R ::

1. The appellant/original accused, **Dhanjibhai Ramabhai Solanki**, residing at Dhasad, Vankar Vas, Tal. Sanand, Dist. Ahmedabad, is released on bail on furnishing personal bond of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only) and surety of like amount before this court on following conditions:

Conditions:

1. At the time of furnishing bail, the appellant/original accused must submit his permanent and current residential address, along with proof of address and details of his mobile number, to the concerned court. No changes shall be made to this information without prior written intimation to this court until further orders.
2. The appellant/original accused must remain present punctually on every scheduled date of the appeal proceedings.

If the accused is in judicial custody, he may be immediately released from the jail provided he is not arrested in some other case.

If any of the above conditions are violated, the bail of the accused shall be considered canceled, and the appellate court shall pass an appropriate order.

Yadi may be send to Jail authority, Sabarmati Central Jail, Ahmedabad
and concerned trial court.
