ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT – 1
IN
CRIMINAL MISC. APPLICATION NO. 230 OF 2026

1) This Court had passed order dated 17/03/2026 wherein, it was recorded that none appears on behalf of the applicant to proceed further with the application. The Investigating Officer was also asked to inform the Court as to why the account of the applicant should be kept frozen.

2) Today also none has remained present on behalf of the applicant, though, the matter is called thrice during the course of the day. The Investigating Officer is present before the Court. Ld. Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Investigating Officer submitted that in the account of the present applicant an amount of Rs.50,00,000/- has been received from Grow More Foundation Trust. It is further stated that applicant was trustee of Grow More Foundation Trust at the relevant time and despite the fact that the land / property could not be sold, he illegally entered into MOU with the main accused – Bhupendrasinh Zala to sell the property for a total sum of Rs.81,51,00,000/- and in this regard an amount of Rs.1,99,00,000/- was deposited from the account of BZ Profit Plus into the account of Grow More Foundation and out of the said amount an amount of Rs.50,00,000/- has been transferred into the account of present applicant who is trustee of Grow More Foundation.

3) On inquiring from the applicant it was stated that he had given loan to the Grow More Foundation Trust but except his very say, nothing has been produced before the Investigating Officer to substantiate his say about providing loan to the Grow More Foundation Trust and in this case it is merely an eyewash without any explanation as to how the applicant was entitled to receive such huge amount of Rs.50,00,000/- which as per the prosecution case the said amount has been travelled from the victims to accused and from accused to trust and thereafter, from the trust the applicant has got Rs.50,00,000/- transferred into his own account. No explanation is revealing from the application about how such huge amount is transferred to the account of applicant nor the applicant or his Ld. Advocate has remained present to offer their explanation though sufficient opportunity has been provided.

4) Thus, in view of facts and circumstances noted hereinabove, this Court do not find any merit in the present application and accordingly following order is passed.

-: ORDER :-

1. The present application is *rejected*.
