: JUDGMENT ::

- (1) The applicant has preferred present application under Section 483(1) of B.N.S.S. 2023, seeking interim bail in connection with FIR I CR No. No.11191028230301/2023, lodged with Vejalpur Police Station, District Ahmedabad for the offence punishable u/s. 302, 506(2), 120(B) of IPC. and Section 135(1) of G.P.Act.
- (2) The present application has been preferred by the applicant seeking interim bail for a period of 30 days. It is submitted by the applicant that he and his two brothers are presently in judicial custody and, therefore, there is no one available to take care of their aged parents. It is further submitted that the applicant is required to make financial arrangements for the maintenance of his family as well as to pay the professional fees of the advocate engaged in the matter. In view of the aforesaid submissions and other grounds mentioned in the application, the applicant has prayed that interim bail be granted.
- (3) The Ld. D.G.P. has submitted that the applicant is charged for serious offence of murder. Here the given grounds are formal and it cannot be permitted so bail may be rejected.
- (4) I have heard the arguments and read the opinion filed by the I.O. I have considered the reasons given by the applicant for granting interim

bail. The applicant is charged under Sections 302, 506(2), 120(B) of IPC. and Section 135(1) of G.P.Act. I have considered the reasons for interim bail. Mere financial crisis or weak economic condition cannot be considered a valid ground for granting interim bail. Interim bail is granted only in exceptional circumstances such as extreme medical emergency or compelling humanitarian reasons. Economic hardship is a common difficulty and does not outweigh the seriousness of allegations or the requirements of the criminal justice process. After considering the same, I pass the following order below application:

- [1]** The present interim bail application filed by the applicant **Badshahkhan Firojkhan Akbarkhan Pathan** is hereby rejected.
