JUDGMENT

1. Applicant has preferred this application seeking temporary modification of bail condition and permission to travel out of Gujarat from 19/3/2026 to 22/3/2026.
2. Ld. Advocate Ms. Payal Rathod appearing on behalf of Ld. Advocate Mr. R.B. Parekh for the applicant submits that applicant has been granted regular bail by this Hon'ble

Court vide order dt.2/9/2025 in Cri. Misc.Appl. No. 2812/2025 in connection with FIR No. I CR No.2/2025 registered with ATS Police Station with suitable conditions including condition No.b, which says that applicant/accused shall not leave local limits of State of Gujarat without prior permission of the Court.

- 2.1 It is submitted that applicant wants to visit Bhuvneshwar for 'Darshan' of deity / pilgrimage purpose from 19/3/2026 to 22/3/2026. Applicant has not breached any bail condition. Applicant is businessman and is permanent resident of the address shown in the cause title. Hence, urged to relax condition no.B of the order dt.2/9/2025 in Cri. Misc.Appl. No. 2812/2025 and permit the applicant to travel out of Gujarat i.e. Bhuvneshwar between 19/3/2026 to 22/3/2026 by allowing the application.
3. Ld. Public Prosecutor Mr. P.M. Trivedi appearing on behalf of Opponent State submits that appropriate order be passed considering facts of the case.
4. Heard Ld. Advocates of the respective parties. This Court has gone through the application and documents annexed to it. This application is preferred by the applicant seeking permission to travel out of Gujarat from 19/3/2026 to 22/3/2026.
- 4.1 It appears that applicant has been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dt.2/9/2025 in Cri. Misc.Appl. No. 2812/2025 in connection with FIR No. I CR No.2/2025 registered with ATS Police Station with suitable conditions including condition No.b, which says that applicant/accused shall not leave local limits of State of

Gujarat without prior permission of the Court.

- 4.2 As per the applicant, he wants to travel out of Gujarat i.e. to Bhuvneshwar from 19/3/2026 to 22/3/2026 for pilgrimage purpose. In support of his contention, applicant has produced copy of Air Tickets from Ahmedabad to Bhuvneshwar, which includes return ticket on 22/3/2026. The prosecution has not brought anything on record about any breach of bail conditions by the applicant. Considering the facts and circumstances as noted hereinabove and the fact that applicant want to travel out of Gujarat for limited period of 4 days only following order is passed in the interest of justice:

ORDER

1. The application is **allowed**.
2. Applicant is permitted to travel out of Gujarat viz. **Bhuvneshwar from 19/3/2026 to 22/3/2026**. Accordingly, condition No.2b of the bail order dt.2/9/2025 in Cri. Misc.Appl. No. 2812/2025 of this Court stands relaxed for the said period.

The applicant shall file an undertaking that trial will not be delayed or hampered on account of his non-availability or absence and he shall remain present before the Court whenever required.
