J U D G E M E N T

(1) The present applicant has filed present bail application under Section

483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, seeking regular bail in connection with the FIR No.I No.I-70/2016, lodged with Aslali Police Station, Ahmedabad for the offence punishable u/s. 364A, 365, 385, 387, 114, 120(B) of IPC.

- (2) The learned advocate representing the applicant has argued that all the major accused are released on regular bail by Hon'ble the High Court of Gujarat, so we pray for benefit of parity. Here the charge-sheet is filed and so considering the other submissions made in the bail application, we may be granted bail.
- (3) The learned DGP has submitted that applicant was absconding since 2016 and he is having permanent resident of Uttar Pradesh so he will flee away if released on regular bail. Further this court has already rejected the bail, so bail may not be granted.
- (4) I have heard the arguments and reviewed the affidavit filed by the Investigating Officer. The record on hand suggests that the offence was lodged in the year 2016 and since then the applicant is absconding. Further the applicant is involved in serious offence of kidnapping. But the record on hand suggests that all the major accused named Kapildev Pandey, Anopsinh Maansinh, Anopsinh Jaysinh were released on regular bail by Hon'ble the High Court of

Gujarat and Seemaben was granted regular bail by this court. As per the guiding principles of ***Rameshbhai Dabhi*** (Gujarat High Court), the applicant is entitled for benefit of parity. Further I have considered the facts on hand with respect to settled parameters for the consideration of bail and accordingly, I pass the following order:

-: O R D E R :-

- [1] The present Regular Bail Application is hereby allowed.
- [2] The applicant/accused **Vikassinh S/o. Hosila Prasadsinh Rajput**, is hereby ordered to be released on regular bail in connection with FIR bearing C.R. No.I-70/2016, lodged with Aslali Police Station, Ahmedabad for the offence punishable u/s. 364A, 365, 385, 387, 114, 120(B) of IPC, on furnishing personal bond of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only) and surety of like amount, before the trial Court subject to following conditions:
 - (1) The applicant/accused shall furnish their permanent residential address along with proof and their contact number before the Court and to the I.O. of concerned Police Station and in case of any change therein, they shall immediately inform to the Police and shall declare their new address in writing before the trial Court at the earliest.
 - (2) The accused shall regularly remain present before the Trial Court.

(3) The applicant/accused shall not take undue advantage of their liberty.

(4) The applicant / accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity.

[3] Yadi be sent to the concerned Police Station.
