J U D G E M E N T

- (1) The present applicant has filed present bail application under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, seeking regular bail in

connection with the FIR No.I No.11192018230091/2023, lodged with Dhandhuka Police Station, Ahmedabad for the offence punishable u/s. 395, 332, 186, 504, 506(2) of IPC.

- (2) The learned advocate representing the applicant has argued that all the major accused are released on bail and so we pray for benefit of parity. My name is not mentioned in the FIR nor the police affidavit reveals my role. Here police has filed charge-sheet. I have applied for regular bail. Hence considering the other submissions made in the bail application, we may be granted regular bail.
- (3) The learned DGP has submitted that accused was a part of a gang who attacked employee of electricity company and helped the other accused in causing injuries to the complainant and the staff present on duty. It is irrelevant that name is not mentioned in the FIR but it is more important that subsequently name disclosed. Hence he may not be given benefit of parity and bail may be rejected.
- (4) I have heard the learned advocates for both sides. I have also perused the affidavit filed by the Investigating Officer, the bail application, and the investigation papers placed on record. Here the record shows that all the major accused are granted regular bail as well as anticipatory bail. Further the role of the present applicant is more or less same as the other accused who are released on regular bail. Hence the

applicant is entitled for parity. Further the applicant has first time applied for regular bail. In that case, if we consider the request for bail in context to settled parameters for consideration of bail such that whether there is any prima facie or reasonable ground to believe that the accused had committed the offence; nature and gravity of the accusation; severity of the punishment in the event of conviction, danger of the accused absconding or fleeing, if released on bail, character, behaviour, means, position and standing of the accused; likelihood of the offence being repeated; reasonable apprehension of the witnesses being influenced and danger, of course, of justice being thwarted by grant of bail, etc. then I am of the opinion that bail should be given to the applicant. Accordingly, the following order is passed:

-: O R D E R :-

- [1] The present Bail Application is hereby allowed.
- [2] The applicant/accused Vanrajbhai Bhimjibhai Gangadiya, is hereby ordered to be released on regular bail in connection with FIR bearing C.R. No.11192018230091/2023, lodged with Dhandhuka Police Station, Ahmedabad for the offence punishable u/s. 395, 332, 186, 504, 506(2) of IPC., on furnishing personal bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only) and surety of like amount, before the trial Court subject to following conditions:
 - (1) The applicant/accused shall furnish their permanent residential address along with proof and their contact number before the

Court and to the I.O. of concerned Police Station and in case of any change therein, they shall immediately inform to the Police and shall declare their new address in writing before the trial Court at the earliest.

- (2) The accused shall regularly remain present before the Trial Court.
- (3) The applicant/accused shall not take undue advantage of their liberty.
- (4) The applicant / accused shall not indulge in any criminal activity.

[3] Yadi be sent to the concerned Police Station and concerned trial court.
