135(1) of The Gujarat Police Act, Section 3(1)(1), 3(2)
of the GujCTOC Act, Section 13(1)(a)(b), 16(1)(a), 17,
18, 20 of the UAPA Act.

ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT – 1

- 1) The applicant – UTP - Imtiyazkhan alias Imtu Mahebubkhan Pathan has preferred this application through jail seeking temporary bail for a period of 30 days on the ground of getting treatment of his shoulder pain.
- 2) It is stated that the applicant is UTP since last 4 years in connection with the aforesaid offence. The applicant was initially treated at Jail dispensary where he was advised to get further treatment at Civil Hospital. It is stated that on 08/01/2026, 15/01/2026, 16/02/2026 and 17/03/2026 he was asked to get treatment at Civil Hospital but the same could not be provided to him as no civil japta in his name was provided. The jail doctor

has provided him treatment by giving medicine and was asked to rest, however, he could get relief in his shoulder pain and therefore, the present application is filed to get temporary bail for a period of 30 days for his medical treatment.

3) Applicant-accused was heard through Jail video conferencing. On inquiring about the treatment he stated that he was taken to Civil hospital once for his shoulder pain and he was advised to get his MRI done which is yet pending. The jail doctor is present before the Court who submitted that MRI of the applicant-accused has not been carried out. Without going any further the Jail Superintendent, Sabarmati Central Jail is directed to ensure that applicant-accused is sent for MRI as advised by the expert doctor who has examined the applicant-accused on last occasion when he was taken to Civil Hospital. The DCP (Headquarter), Ahmedabad shall also ensure that civil japta is provided to the jail authorities so as to take the applicant-accused for medical treatment of his shoulder pain, MRI examination as advised by the doctor of Civil Hospital, without fail. Compliance of these directions be made to the Court within three days by the Shri Gaurav Agrawal, IPS, Jail Superintendent, Sabarmati Central Jail, Ahmedabad. A copy of this order be handed over to Learned Special Public Prosecutor Mr. Amit Patel who shall forward this order to Jail Superintendent, Sabarmati Central Jail, Ahmedabad for its compliance and a copy of this order be also sent to the concerned authorities through e-mail.
