

**ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT ONE**

The parties i.e. the claimant(s) and Insurance Company have submitted compromise pursis to the effect that as the matter has been amicably settled between them for a sum of **Rs.2,40,000/- (Rs. Two Lakh Forty Thousand only)** as full and final compensation. The same is read over and explained to the parties and they have voluntarily accepted the same. I am also satisfied that it is both legal and within the purview of subject matter of the Claim Petition and also in the interest of claimant. The compromise is, therefore recorded and I pass following order :-

**:- ORDER :-**

- ◆ The Opponent-TATA AIG General Insurance Co. Ltd. shall pay the compromise amount **within a period of 03 months** from the date of compromise, failing which the compromise amount shall carry the simple rate at 09% per annum from the date of the compromise.
- ◆ If the claimant has deposited the Court fees, then in that case, certificate for refund of Court fees be issued as per rules.
- ◆ The parties shall bear their own cost.
- ◆ Order regarding payment and investment of the compensation amount shall be made at the time of disbursement of the amount.
- ◆ Award be drawn, accordingly.
