COMMITMENT ORDER

1. The above named accused have been sent to face trial by the
Station House Officer, Police Station City, Phagwara for the commission
of offences under section 306, 34 IPC.
2. Briefly, the prosecution case is that on 5.10.2021 Inspector
Shaminder Singh was present at Palahi Road, where complainant
Charanjit Singh along with Dilpreet Singh came present. Charnajit Singh
got recorded his statement with the I.O. that he is Agriculturist. He has

two sons namely Manpreet Singh @ Sonu and Jaspreet Singh. Manpreet Singh was married to Primaljit Kaur in the year 2015. A son was born out of the wedlock namely Dilbar Singh. Manpreet Singh used to stay separately on the upper portion of the house. Around two years back, Primaljit Kaur taken on account of occasion of Rakhi by her mother and grand mother along with Dilbar Singh to Bhattewad. After the occasion of Rakhi his son requested Primaljit Kaur to return back to her matrimonial house, but she refused. Even the mother of Primaljit Kaur refused to sent back her daughter. Four days before 5.10.2021, Manpreet Singh along with Dilpreet Singh cousin brother went to his in-law house, but returned back alone. He was upset. He told him and his mother Paramjit Kaur that while he had gone to village Bhattewad to take back his wife, he was insulted by Primaljit Kaur, his mother-in-law Ranjit Kaur and one Sikh person present there. They even insulted his parents, which he could not tolerate. All of them have insisted him to die. He also told he will commit suicide. They made his son understand. Today, when at about 12:30 p.m., when his wife went up stairs to call his son, she found that her son Sonu committed suicide by hanging himself with the ceiling fan. On raising alarm, he along with his nephew Satbir Singh also went up stairs and found his son hanged with the fan. They want to take his son hospital for treatment, but he was dead. They recovered one phone having sim No.95172-28288, in which he recorded different videos before his death and implicate his mother-in-law Ranjit Kaur, wife Primaljit Kaur and one another Sikh person about whom they do not know. He further stated that

his son Manpreet Singh committed suicide on the abutment of accused. On the basis of statement of complainant, FIR was registered. Rough site plan of place of occurrence was prepared. Statements of witnesses were recorded. After completion of necessary formalities, instant challan was presented before court.

3. On presentation of challan in the court, copies of documents as required under section 207 Cr.P.C were supplied to accused free of costs.

4. I have heard the learned APP for the State, accused and gone through the file very carefully.

5. From the perusal of the file, I find that a prima facie case for offence under section 306, 34 IPC appears to be made out against the accused. Offence under section 306 IPC is exclusively triable by the Court of Sessions. As such, this case is committed to the court of learned Sessions Judge, Kapurthala for trial for **15.9.2022**. The accused on bail are directed to appear in the Court of learned Sessions Judge, Kapurthala on the date fixed at 10:00 AM sharp. Learned APP for State be also notified about the commitment of the case and Ahlmad concerned is directed to send the file complete in all respects, to the Court of Learned Sessions Judge, Kapurthala, well before the date fixed, after making entry in the relevant record.
