



ORDER BELOW EXH.08 IN S.C.C. NO.3505/2024.

(State of Maharashtra V/s Accused No.1 Sahebrao)

1. The accused No.1 Sahebrao Gangadhar Datir is facing the trial for the offence punishable under section 135 of Maharashtra Police Act. The accused has filed the present application and prayed for no objection of this Court for issuance of passport as the said offence is still pending before this Court.
2. On the other hand, learned APP opposed the application. She submitted that, accused may not appear before the court after he gets passport and there is possibility that, he may abscond. Hence, application be rejected.
3. Heard learned advocate for accused and learned APP. Perused the application and say. It is part of record that, the applicant is accused No.1 in present case. The offence leveled against accused No.1 is triable by this court. It is pertinent to mention here that, by way of present application, the accused No.1 is seeking no objection of this court, only for issuance of his passport and he has not prayed for any permission to travel abroad. Therefore, in my opinion, there is no hurdle to grant permission / no objection for issuance of passport. Hence, considering the nature of allegations, requirements of law and right of accused No.1, I proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

1. Application is allowed.
2. This Court has “No Objection” to issue the passport to applicant/accused namely Sahebrao Gangadhar Datir (accused No.1) subject to condition that he shall comply all the legal formalities of passport authority.
3. Applicant/accused no.1 shall direct that, he shall appear on each date of the present case.
