// R E F E R R A L O R D E R //

Upon going through the record of the case and further considering the facts and circumstances of the case, it appears to this Court that, complainant has filed the present case u/s 25 of the Payment and settlement Act **or** u/s 138 of the Negotiable Instrument Act and there exist elements of a settlement which may be acceptable to the parties. Therefore, I refer this Case for exploring the possibilities of settlement through Mediation, on the following conditions.

(1) Parties to the lis and their Advocates/Attorneys shall remain present along with the necessary Case papers before Mediation Centre, DLSA Chief Judicial Magistrate Courts, Ahmedabad City on the date fixed by Mediation Centre, Chief Judicial Magistrate Courts, Ahmedabad City.

(2) Mediation process/proceeding shall be conducted by the Full time Secretary with the help of trained mediators. In Court Annexed mediation, the Co-ordinator of the Mediation Centre shall appoint the mediator as he may deem fit.

(3) In Case of failure of resolution of the referred dispute, the Mediator shall inform the Mediation Centre, by a report, only

stating that MEDIATION HAS BEEN UNSUCCESSFUL and the Co-ordinator of the Mediation Centre shall inform the same to this Court.

(4) When an agreement is reached between the parties with regard to all the issues in the suit or proceeding or some of the issues, the same shall be reduced to writing and signed by the parties or their constituted Attorney/s, and Counsel/s, if any.

(5) The agreement of the parties so signed shall be submitted to the co-ordinator, Mediation Centre, who shall, with a covering letter signed by him forward the same to this Court.

(6) On the expiry of 90 from the date fixed for the first appearance of the parties before the mediator, the mediation shall stand terminated, unless this Court, either suo moto, or upon request by any of the parties, and upon hearing all the parties, is of the view that extension of time is necessary or may be useful; but such extension shall not be beyond a further period of thirty days.

(7) Soft Copy of case papers shall be forwarded to Mediation Centre, forthwith.
