The original petition having been finally heard on 04/03/2026 and the Tribunal on the same day passed the following:-

AWARD

This petition is u/Ss 166(1) and 140 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 seeking compensation on account of the injuries sustained by the petitioner in a motor vehicle accident. The 1st respondent is the RC owner, 2nd respondent is the driver and 3rd respondent is the insurer of the vehicle involved in that accident.

Notices were served to the respondents for their appearance.

Subsequently during the course of proceedings, the petitioner and the respondent **No.3** have arrived at an out of court settlement and filed a Joint Memo before this Tribunal that the matter was settled for **₹4,50,000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Fifty Thousand only)** towards full satisfaction of the claim and the **respondent No.3** has agreed to pay that amount. The parties sought for an award in terms of that compromise. The Joint Memo dated 05/02/2026 is accepted.

In the result, this Petition is allowed and the award is passed as follows:-

- (1). The **3rd** respondent is directed to pay a total amount of **₹4,50,000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Fifty Thousand only)** to the petitioner towards compensation.
- (2). **R3**/insurer shall deposit the award amount due to the petitioner in his Savings Bank Account shown below, directly by National Electronic Fund Transfer (NEFT) / Real Time Gross Settlement (RTGS) or any other electronic mode within 90 days, failing which the interest will be charged at 9% per annum from the date of the award.

- (3). After depositing the amount, **R3** insurer shall submit to the Tribunal a copy of the bank advice and a memo in the prescribed format.
- (4). **R3** insurer shall also serve a copy of the payment advice, along with a copy of the above memo, to the petitioner/or his counsel.
- (5). **R3**/insurer shall also provide form-16A under the Income Tax Act 1961 to the petitioner.
- (6). The office is further directed to make necessary entries in the Cheque Issue Register or any other Registers concerned, evidencing payment of above amount to the petitioner.
- (7). The Joint Memo shall also form part of this award.
- (8). Parties shall bear their respective costs.
