1. In view of the Pursis Exh.60 passed by both the parties, the compromise has been taken place between the parties in National Lok Adalat held on 14.03.2026. The petitioner is ready and willing to accept compensation amount of Rs.3,00,000/- [Rupees Three Lac Only] from the opponent No.3-Insurance Company and they admit the same. The compromise is therefore recorded.
2. Deducting amount of medical expenses if any from the awarded amount, 50% amount be invested as fixed deposit in any nationalized bank for initial period of five years. The remaining 50% amount be paid to the claimant by account payee cheque/s or RTGS/NEFT forthwith along with whatever amount of medical bills.
3. As per the direction made by the Ho'ble Supreme Court in W.P.(Civil) No.534 of 2020 (Bajaj Allianz General Insurance Company Pvt.Ltd. Vs. Union of India and others dt.16.11.2021, the insurance company is hereby directed that the awarded amount be deposit in to the following Bank Account maintained by this Tribunal through RTGS/NEFT.

5. On such deposit being made, the opponent Insurance Company shall submit a letter to the office of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal (Main), Arvalli At Modasa enclosing a copy of the bank advice in the prescribed format as above.
6. The applicant is directed to furnish his/her bank particular i.e her/his Bank Name, Bank Account Number/s, Type Of Account, Branch Name, IFSC code of concerned Bank, copy of PAN Card and copy of Aadhar Card before registry. If at present the applicant is not having bank account in that case the applicant is directed to furnish the same within seven days from today and thereafter, Registry is directed to

make disbursement of the amount of compensation accordingly.

7. The amount of Court fees if paid be refunded to applicant as provided under Section 21 of The Legal Services Authority Act, 1987. The present matter is disposed of accordingly.
8. No order as to costs.
9. Award to be drawn up in terms and conditions of the compromise.
