Sarabjit Kaur Vs. State of Punjab etc.

2. Learned counsel for applicant-accused-Sarabjit Kaur contended that the applicant-accused and the complainant are having civil dispute in between them as they have entered into an agreement to sell with regard to the property/land of the applicant. But now due to some dispute the same could not be matured for which the complainant threatened that they will entangle the applicant-accused in some false criminal case by giving a civil matter the colour of criminal matter.

3. On the other hand, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor on instructions from Gursewak Singh HC posted at PS City Barnala has stated that one complaint, bearing No.2406/LPC dated 23.12.2025 has been filed by Paramjit Kaur, wife of Raj Singh, resident of Near Gurudwara Baba Gandha Singh, Barnala against the applicant-accused-Sarabjit Kaur and Ranjit Singh, Balwinder Sharma.

4. Statement of Gursewak Singh HC has also been recorded to the said effect.

5. After considering the above, since in the present matter, no FIR has been registered against the applicant-accused till date and only one application is pending for inquiry and in case of arrest of the applicant-accused pursuant to

registration of FIR on the basis of complaint moved by Paramjit Kaur, ten days prior notice will be given to the applicant-accused.

6. The bail application stands disposed of accordingly.

7. File be consigned to the Judicial Record Room, Barnala, after due compliance.
