ORDER:-

1. This is an application taken out by the defendant for extension of time to remove the articles from the suit premises on the ground that transportation is not available today.

2. The application is resisted by the plaintiffs on the ground that more than sufficient time was granted to the defendants to remove the articles. The defendant is causing harassment and inconvenience to the plaintiffs. The plaintiffs have prayed for rejection of the application.

3. Heard defendant in-person and Ld. Advocate for the plaintiff.

4. The reason assigned that transportation is not available,

appears to be satisfactory. It is informed by the bailiff that more than 50% of the articles are removed by the defendants. Therefore, time as prayed may be extended in the interest of justice. Hence, the following order.

ORDER

1. The application Exh.54 is allowed.
2. Time to remove the articles which was fixed as per order passed below Exh.1 dated 16.07.2019 is extended and the defendant is permitted to remove articles on 22.07.2019 and 23.07.2019 strictly as a last chance.
