Accordingly.....it is ORDERED

that the accused Bumba Karmakar is hereby found guilty of the Charge under section 143 Rly Act, as per the findings of this Court against him, in this JPG RPF Post Case No. 15 of 2022 dated 10-09-2022, in terms with section 255(2) of the CrPC, 1973 and he is hereby convicted for such offence.

It is necessary to hear the convicts on point of sentence at this stage, so the pronouncement of award of conviction is deferred for next two hours.

Heard the Convict on point of sentence. Heard the Ld. Defence Adv and Ld. PP.

The convict and his Ld. Adv plead innocence, including the claim that he has been falsely implicated in this case and the Convict again asserts that he may be given the option of probation. Considered.

Accordingly, it is..... ORDERED

that the accused is find guilty & convicted for the offence under section 143 Rly Act. The convict is heard on the point of sentence. Convict has stated that he is the sole bread earner and his family is dependent on him entirely & it is his first offence. Considering all,that the convict namely, Bumba Karmakar is sentenced to pay fine off Rs. 5000/- for the offence under section 143 Rly Act. In default of payment of fine the convict will suffer SI of 30 days.

The seized alamats, if any, be confiscated to the State/be accordingly disposed of on expiry of period of appeal.

Hand over a copy of Judgement free of cost to the convict at once as per section 363(1) of the CrPC. The convicted person is also informed of his right of appeal against the Judgement and order of conviction and sentence.
