Ld. Counsel for the accused has filed an application for bail under section 480 BNSS of accused Ashraf.

Ld. counsel for the accused submits that accused is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this present case. That accused is in JC since 11.03.2026. That accused is ready to furnish reliable surety, hence he should be released on bail.

IO has filed reply to the bail application opposing the same.

Submissions heard.

Considering overall facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it fit to allow the bail application of the accused. Accused is admitted to bail on furnishing a personal bond and one sound surety in the sum of ₹15,000/- to the satisfaction of Court concerned/Ld. Duty MM subject to the following conditions:

- (i) the accused shall attend the Court as per the conditions of the bond to be executed,
- (ii) accused shall not commit any other offence including any offence of similar nature,
- (iii) accused shall not directly / indirectly induce, give threat, or in any way dissuade the witnesses/persons acquitted with the facts of the case,
- (iv) accused shall not tamper any evidence and shall co-operate in the investigation, in case the investigation is still pending,
- (v) accused shall not leave India without prior permission of this Court.
- (vi) accused shall intimate the IO/Court concerned regarding the address change immediately if he changes his address from the one available on record.

Violations of any of the conditions as mentioned above shall be a ground for cancellation of the bail.

Nothing mentioned herein shall have any bearing on the merits of the case.
