O R D E R

1. This application for regular bail has been filed by applicant/accused, Sukhwinder Singh alias Bunty son of Tarlochan Singh, in case FIR No.64 dated 09.03.2019 for offence under section 379-B/

(2)/411/201 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadar, Amritsar.

2. On notice, Public Prosecutor opposed the bail application.

3. I have heard counsel for applicant/accused and the Public Prosecutor for the State and have gone through the record.

4. As per allegations appearing on the record, on 09.03.2019 one motorcyclist, who, was riding on a black motor cycle snatched the purse of complainant Vijay Kalia which was having cash worth Rs.2,500/- and one gold chain. The matter was report to the police. During investigation of the case, applicant Sukhwinder Singh was arrested in this case on 10.07.2019. There are also allegations that while in police custody, applicant suffered disclosure statement regarding his involvement in the abovesaid incident of snatching and he got recovered the amount of Rs.500/- out of the said snatched amount alongwith photocopy of the Aadhar card of complainant.

5. The applicant is in custody for the last more than three months. The challan has already been presented in the court of Ilqa magistrate on completion of investigation. It will take time for conclusion of trial. The alleged recoveries have already been effected in this case. So, no purpose will be served by detaining the applicant in custody for any

further period.

6. Thus, without commenting upon merits of the case, this bail application is allowed and applicant is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount, to the satisfaction of Illaqa/duty magistrate, subject to the following terms and conditions :-

- i) that accused shall not give any threat or inducement to any prosecution witness;
- ii) that accused shall not leave India without prior permission of the court.

Copy of this order be sent to the court of Illaqa magistrate, for compliance.
