

Sunita versus Naresh Kumar

Heard.

On the strength of application for transfer, learned counsel for the applicant has contended that the civil suit titled as "Naresh Kumar versus Sunita and Another bearing No. CS-1355-2024" pending in the Court of Ms. Shashi Himshikha, Learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Palwal and another civil suit titled as "Sunita versus Naresh Kumar bearing No. CS-169-2025" pending in the Court of Ms. Bipasha Khatana, Learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Palwal are arising out of same suit property and the matter involved in both civil suits are identical and inter connected, hence, are liable to be decided by one and the same Court in order to adjudicate the matter completely and effectually.

Be that as it may, since both the civil suits are arising out of same suit property and matter is also identical, this application is **allowed** and civil suit titled as "**Sunita versus Naresh Kumar bearing No. CS-169-2025**" is withdrawn from the Court of Ms. Bipasha Khatana, Learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Palwal and is transferred to the Court of Ms. Shashi

Himshikha, Learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Palwal for disposal in accordance with law. A copy of this order be sent to concerned Courts immediately. File be consigned to the record room, after due compliance.
