



**IN THE MOTOR ACCIDENT CLAIMS TRIBUNAL
(AUXI.) & 3rd ADDITIONAL DISTRICT COURT, B.K.
DISTRICT @ PALANPUR**

Order Below Exh.1 in M.A.C.P.Misc.Appli.No.624/2026

1. The present application has been preferred by applicants for releasing the award amount which was passed in MACP No.144/2015 dtd.09/10/2019 and is lying in FDR in the name of Nazir, District Court.
2. Looking to the endorsement made by the Registry, opponent insurance company has deposited an amount of Rs.25,000/- as per verification report of Nazir bearing 'C' No.724/2019-20 dtd.27/01/2020 and Rs.6,78,590/- as per verification report of Nazir bearing 'C' No.58/2020-21 dtd.15/07/2020 and both of them are lying in FDR's in the name of Nazir, District Court. It further appears that opponent insurance company has preferred R/First Appeal

No.1202/2020 before the Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat wherein the Ld. Advocate for the opponent has made endorsement at Exh.1 to pass necessary order as per the direction of the Hon'ble High Court.

3. Further looking to the R/First Appeal No.1202/2020, the Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat has passed order order dtd.06/02/2026 which is as under:-

*"2. Learned advocate for the respondents pointed out that the captioned appeal may not deserve the consideration on merits owing to the smallness of the amount awarded to the claimant. It is noticed that the learned Tribunal has awarded amount of **Rs.4,84,500/-** to the claimant. This is a small and meager amount and considering the aspect of having no dispute in regards to the road accident, I am of the opinion that this appeal may not deserve consideration, more particularly, on the ground of smallness of amount. Accordingly, present first appeal stands dismissed.*

6. R & P, if any, to be sent back to the concerned Court immediately. The entire award amount be disbursed and released in favour of claimant/s after due verification by transferring said amount/s to the account/s of claimant/s by RTGS or NEFT."

4. Thus as per the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat in the above First Appeal, said First Appeal has been dismissed by the Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat and the award amount which is invested in FDR in the name of Nazir be disbursed and thereafter the entire amount shall be paid to the applicants and so as per the order of the Hon'ble High Court the following order is passed :-

ORDER

1. The present M.A.C. Misc. Application is allowed.
2. Nazir, District Court is hereby directed to first of all disburse the FDR's of Rs.25,000/- & Rs.6,78,590/- which is lying in his name along with interest accrued and after disbursement of the same as per the order of

the Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat in R/First Appeal No.1202/2020 dtd.06/02/2026, the entire award amount shall be paid to the claimants in their bank accounts by RTGS or NEFT.

3. Necessary payment order shall be made as per decree drawn.
4. Payment be made through either mode A/c. Payee Cheque/NEFT/RTGS after proper verification.
