J U D G M E N T

1. Present applicant has filed present application under Section 24 of C.P.C. for trial of M.A.C.P. No. 29/2024 pending in the M.A.C. Tribunal (Auxiliary), Court of learned 6th Additional District Judge, Deesa and M.A.C.P. No. 28/2024 pending in the M.A.C. Tribunal (Auxiliary), Court of learned 7th Additional District Judge, Deesa by the same Tribunal.

2. Notice was issued. L.A. Mr. N. L. Thakor, appearing for the opponent No.1 has filed a Pursis at Exh.5 declaring that he has no objection if present application is allowed and trial of both the claim petitions are conducted by the same Tribunal. L.A. Mr. D. K. Thakor, appearing for the opponent No.2 has made an endorsement on this application that he has no objection if present application is allowed.
3. Having heard both the sides and upon going through the contents of the application and documentary evidence available on record at Mark 3/1 & 3/2, it appears that M.A.C.P. No. 29/2024 is pending in the M.A.C. Tribunal (Auxi.), Court of learned 6th Additional District Judge, Deesa at the stage of service of summons/notice and M.A.C.P.
