



**2nd Additional District Court and Motor Accident Claim
Tribunal (Auxiliary), Palanpur, Dist. Banaskantha**

ORDER BELOW EXH.1 IN MACP NO.374/2025

(1) Applicants and Opponent No.2 insurer of the errant vehicle had reached to amicable settlement in regards to dispute in National Lok Adalat and as such they have filed compromise purshis at **Exh-12**. Parties to the petition read over to the same. The terms and conditions of the compromise purshis are admitted upon the parties satisfaction. Compromise purshis is recorded.

(2) The present matter is disposed off in terms of compromise pursis at **Exh-12**. The Opponent No.3 shall deposit amount of **Rs.8,25,000/- (Rupees Eight Lakhs Twenty Five Thousand Only)** being agreed settlement amount less payment made if any under NFL, within 1 month in this Tribunal. Failing which the applicant shall be entitled for the yearly interest at 9% on awarded amount, after expiry of 1 month.

(3) The Opponent No.2 is directed to deposit the amount of compensation through RTGS/NEFT in **Bank Account Details of Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Banaskantha At Palanpur** as under :

(4) Out of the awarded compensation amount, 50% of the amount shall be invested in fixed deposit in the name of present applicants in any nationalized bank for a period of FIVE YEARS and thereafter from the remaining 50% of the amount, **60% shall be paid to Applicant No.1 and 20% each shall be paid to**

Applicant Nos.2 & 3 equally in their bank account through A/c. Payee Cheque/RTGS/NEFT after proper verification.

(5) This claim petition against rest of the opponent/s are disposed off accordingly. The apportionment and disbursement order if any shall be passed after awarded amount is deposited with the Tribunal.

(6) Award be drawn accordingly.

(7) The Applicants are entitled to get refund of Court Fees, if any, paid by the applicants, as per Government Notification No. L/28/09 NALSA, Dated. 14/10/2009 issued by National Legal Services Authority.

(8) Opponent/s is/are directed to scrupulously follow the guidelines issued by the **Honorable High Court of Gujarat** in the case of **Hansagauri Prafulchandra Ladhani & Ors. V/s. Oriental Insurance Co. Ltd. & Ors. [2007 ACJ 1897]** in respect of TDS.
