
REGULAR CIVIL SUIT NO. 15 OF 2025

Order below Exh.1 :

1. By way of filing the withdrawal pursis at Exh.24, the plaintiff desires not to proceed with the present suit and, accordingly she sought permission to withdraw the present suit unconditionally.

2. Read the pursis at Exh.24 and perused the entire record. Heard Mr. J.C. Trivedi, learned advocate appearing for the plaintiff and Mr. B.K. Joshi, learned advocate appearing for the defendants. It appears from the record, that the plaintiff has filed the present suit for specific performance of the agreement as well as for declaration and permanent injunction against the defendants. However, during the pendency of the present suit, both the parties have arrived at amicable settlement and hence, the plaintiff desires not to proceed with the present suit and accordingly the plaintiff seeks permission to withdraw the present suit and, therefore, the permission to withdraw the present suit is required to be granted.

3. In view of the withdrawal pursis at Exh.24, the present suit is disposed of as withdrawn under Order 23 Rule 1(1) of the Code of Civil Procedure with no order as to costs.

4. Order of interim injunction passed below application at Exh.5 on 4th November, 2025 is hereby vacated forthwith.

5. Full Court Fee Refund Certificate be issued in the name of the plaintiff – Padhiyar Minaben Akashkumar.
