

State Vs Juvenile in conflict with law

Arguments heard. Vide separate judgment of even date, juveniles facing inquiry before the Board has been acquitted of the notice served to Them. Their bail bonds and surety bonds stand discharged. Case property be disposed of under rules after the expiry of period of appeal/revision, if any.

Sub-section (3) of Section 100 of The Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 (for short the 'Act') specifically bars appeal from order of acquittal made by the Board in respect of juvenile alleged to have committed an offence, as such there is no need for bonds under section 437 of The Code of Criminal Procedure. They be released from detention, if not required in any other case. File be consigned to the record room, after due compliance.
