ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT 1

1. Present criminal enquiry pertains to the complaint filed on behalf of the Enquiry officer from the RPF Post Dhasa, Bhavnagar, Mr. Dinesh Pandey against the accused for an offence punishable under the provisions of Section 160(2) & 147 of the Railway Act, 1989.
2. The accused is present before the Court and is represented by Learned Advocate Mr. A.P Parekh. As per the mandate provided in 1st Proviso of Section 223 BNSS, 2023, the accused was accorded an opportunity of being heard before taking cognizance of an offence and is heard accordingly.
3. After hearing the proposed accused as well as Ld. PP for RPF (Railway) on point of cognizance and perusal of record, I am of the opinion that there is sufficient ground for proceeding against the accused and the present case is a warrant triable case, yet, since the accused is present before this Court, no warrant or summons is issued against him.
4. Since there are sufficient grounds to proceed against the accused persons, I hereby take cognizance of the offence under Section 160(2) of Railway Act, 1989. Accordingly, as per Section 227 of BNSS, 2023, it is hereby directed that the present complaint be registered as Criminal Case (Railways) and the criminal enquiry is disposed of accordingly.
5. Copy of complaint be supplied to the accused against acknowledgement. The matter is adjourned for pre - charge evidence of the prosecution.

6. Presence of the complainant is exempted till further orders and Ld. PP is directed to prosecute this complaint on behalf of the complainant.
