

ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT - 1

1. The present application is filed by the applicant who seeks to be permitted to sue as indigent person for filing appeal against the order and decree passed by the learned Additional Senior Civil Judge, Botad in Regular SP.C.S No.27/2018 dated 07/10/2025.
2. I have perused the application and the affidavit filed in support thereof. The schedule annexed to the present application indicates that the applicant do not possess any immovable property and the value of his movable property is such that he is entitled to be recognized as indigent person within the meaning of Order 33, Rule 1 of the Code of Civil Procedure.
3. A notice was ordered to be issued upon the State and the State has appeared through learned D.G.P., who has stated that the applicant has not produced any documentary proof in support of the application and present application may kindly be dismissed. Having considered the same, I am of the opinion that it does not, in any manner, hinder the applicant from being granted the relief sought in the present application.
4. The Constitution of our country confers rights upon every citizen to equally before law. Merely, because persons do not have the financial means, they cannot be prevented from enforcing their legal rights in a Court of Law. In my opinion, therefore, the present application is required to be allowed and in the circumstances, I pass the following order :-

ORDER

- (i) The Application is allowed.
- (ii) The applicant is permitted to sue as indigent person and in the circumstances, the appeal is ordered to stand registered and appropriately numbered and notices be served upon the opponents thereof.
- (iii) The present application is ordered to stand accordingly disposed of.
