

ORDER BELOW EXH.1
(M.A.C.P. No. 02 OF 2024)

1. The parties to the proceedings have entered into compromise and have submitted Compromise Pursis vide Exh.34, which is recorded accordingly.
2. The parties to the proceedings have entered into compromise settling the claim to the tune of **Rs.21,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty One Lakh Only)**. Thus, this Tribunal is of the opinion that the settlement arrived between the parties, is legal and within the purview of subject matter of the claim petition. Hence, following order is passed:

:: ORDER ::

1. The opponent – Insurance Company is hereby directed to deposit the above settlement amount of **Rs.21,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty One Lakh Only)** in the office of this Tribunal towards full & final compensation.
2. The office shall not deduct or recover the amount of Court fees from the awarded amount deposited with this Tribunal, as the matter is compromised in National Lok-Adalat.
3. Court Fees Refund Certificate, as the case may be, be issued in the names of the claimants, provided the claimants have paid Court fees, if any.
4. The total amount of compensation shall be disbursed amongst the claimants equally, in the ratio of **50% amount** be invested in any Nationalized Bank to the choice of the claimant/s for a period of five years with usual conditions about prohibition and non-grant of any loan or advance against the said FDR. However, the claimants are entitled to receive periodical interest as and when accrue thereon and upon maturity of the F. D. Receipt, the concerned bank shall disburse/pay the accrued/matured amount to the claimant/s without any further order from this Tribunal. Remaining **50% amount** be paid to the claimants by way of RTGS/NEFT on proper verification and identification.
5. The present claim petition accordingly stands disposed off in National Lok-Adalat.
6. Award be drawn accordingly.
